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PLATFORM STATEMENT

Dear GSG Family,

I know from the very beginning that it is going to be a very demanding job requiring a tremendous amount of effort and time from me, but in the end the impact that it will have is worth it.

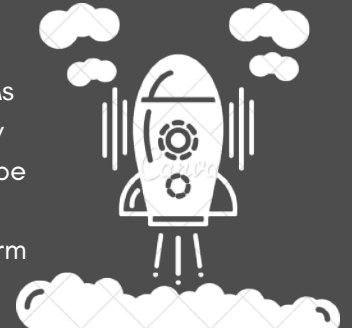

The duties of Secretary General need revision and more definition. Uptil now it majorly involves overseeing the management of GSG and ensuring that it operates in a manner that is consistent with its guiding documents and goals and objectives. Keeping that in mind, I present to you a preliminary plan of action that would be further evaluated after a handover from past SecGen and a general assessment of best practices, challenges and struggles encountered by the SecGen Office.

HANDOVER

- Understand and catch up with the current working of SecGen Office through OLMs with current SecGen. Small handover period might create some challenges but my experience in different leadership positions makes me feel confident that I would be able to presume the functions and responsibility of the role real fast.
- I would also maintain a journal and create handover documents throughout the term to help prepare the next SecGen for office.



PLANS

Minute Taking and Preservation

I would be capacitating my assistants with the task of minute taking and would have them join EB meetings as minute takers. I would overlook the process and finalize them after the meeting. For Legislative Assemblies, I would be creating a team of Secretary and Secretary Assistants and would overlook the task. This would ensure that I am able to focus on the content and my contribution to the EB meetings and Legislative Assembly, and decision making of the GSG. Moreover, this process would involve more stakeholders and eventually capacitate more individuals for future. The minutes would be maintained in a G drive folder throughout the term for easy access and the folder would eventually be converted into an archive after the term ends.

GSG's guiding documents

I would be working with the EB and rest of the stakeholders in updating GSG guiding documents especially the constitution with the aim to make it more precise and accurate.

The process would involve identification of changes, followed by EB discussion, input from all stakeholders and eventually final proposition which could be adopted at the next Legislative Assembly. I would also work on introduction of regulations to overlook implementation of the guiding documents and introduce accountability mechanisms. This would ensure continuous scrutiny of the

implementation process as well as the content of regulations and guiding documents and highlight areas that need to be improved.

Dissemination of Knowledge

For effective dissemination of institutional knowledge, I would work with the VPEA and VPC to develop GSG central servers for emails and updating the website with the documents that would guide and capacitate members.

Maintenance of Archives

I would maintain all data on the gmail drive and organise it to preserve institutional history. We would also explore documentation and other measures that we can take.

Legislative Assemblies and Elections

I would work with the team in organising the next Legislative Assembly and elections. I would also explore options and ways through which this process of organizing the meeting and elections could be further regulated and decentralised with more involvement from different stakeholders and platforms.

Consultation Group

I would also work on the development and maintenance of members of the Consultation group and regulate the dialogue through this avenue. I would collect input and suggestions and evaluate their integration into our work. Once the evaluation is complete, the outcomes would be shared and presented to be implemented on different focus areas.
